Topic # 3:	Discussion & Approval on MMS program curriculum structure & detailed		
• •	syllabus (Sem II & IV) and Course Evaluation		

Dr. Radhika Wadhera outlined the credit allocation for semesters 2 and 4, Discussion: confirming that semester 2 consists of 26 credits, including 4 credits for OJT. In semester 4, students will complete a winter internship and three subjects totaling 10 credits, with a focus on skill development to prepare students for employment. The structure aims to balance academic learning with practical experience. Prof. Subhash Shinde suggested that online courses can be incorporated into the curriculum, allowing students to earn credits through elearning. Dr. Wadhera acknowledged the need to ensure that these courses align with NHEQF and NSQF standards. They also discussed inclusion of Swayam courses in Sem- IV as elective of 2 credits Dr. Farheen Ahmad provided a detailed breakdown of the curriculum, emphasizing the balance between management subjects and skill enhancement courses, totaling 104 credits over two years and discussing in detail about all subjects of Semester 2 and Semester 4. Dr. Farheen outlined assessment strategies for various courses, focusing on a 50-50% rubric system for project-oriented subjects to increase student engagement. Dr. Uttam Kolekar proposed incorporating credits for fellowships from foreign universities, which the council acknowledged as a valuable suggestion. Mrs. Sharmishtha Jadhav seconded and told that we are working on foreign collaborations with universities of repute for elearning courses Dr. Dinesh Gabhane added, in order to encourage Research ecosystem, a mandatory course namely Research paper of 2 credits has been introduced in Sem IV. Dr. Sudhir Sawarkar appreciated the efforts and suggested to modify the name of the subject. After detailed discussion the name for this course was decided as "Academic Research Writing" It was resolved to explore e-learning courses from recognized platforms Resolution # 3.1: as credit courses It was resolved to modify "Research paper" course name and present it in Resolution # 3.2: Governing Body meeting for approval It was resolved to adopt the Curriculum Structure (scheme), detailed Resolution # 3.3: syllabus and Course Evaluation for Sem 2 and Sem 4, as approved by BoS. Discuss and recommend Governing Body the scheme of awards for Topic # 4: meritorious students Scheme of awards for meritorious students was discussed in detail Discussion: Ms. Ashvini Jadhav proposed to sponsor certificate courses from Universities of repute to the meritorious students.
